- Communicate any unsafe conditions or wear and/or damage of equipment to the Supervisor in order to facilitate corrective action;
- Complete Work Orders and Field Level Risk Assessment Cards, following Core Industrial L.P. standards; and
- Provide feedback to supervision regarding any Site deficiencies.
